



Personal, Social and Emotional- showing an interest in classroom activities through observation and participation; building relationships through gesture and talk; communicating freely about home and community.

Literacy- showing an awareness of rhyme and alliteration; developing an interest in books; listening and responding to stories and discussions; using clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning.

Problem solving, Reason and Maths- counting and recognising numbers 1 – 10; recognising differences in quantities when comparing sets of objects.

Knowledge and understanding of the world- observing selecting and manipulating objects and materials. Identifying simple features and significant personal events.

Physical Development – showing appropriate control with small scale movements and an awareness of space.

Creative Development- exploring different media and trying to capture experiences by mixing red, yellow and oranges.
