This half term we are learning:

Literacy - All about features of non-fiction texts, such as captions and labels. We are also practising forming our letters correctly and writing sentences using capital letters and full stops. We are practising our initial sounds and using them to spell and read words with at least three or four letters, as well as trying to learn to read our sight recognition high frequency words.

Numeracy - All about sequencing and counting to at least 20, and understanding the value of each digit in teens numbers. We have also been finding out one more and one less, adding and subtracting numbers to at least 10, naming and describing the properties of simple 2-d and 3-d shapes and organising and interpreting data in tables and lists.

Science - All about our sense of hearing. We have been distinguishing and identifying different sounds and have been exploring sounds using instruments.

ICT- To be able to switch on a computer and select a program, to select and drag an item using the mouse with increasing levels of accuracy and co-ordination and how to close a program and shut down a computer.

Geography - All about seaside destinations and making comparisons between our local area and that of a seaside location.

Art- How to explore patterns and shape through painting.

Music- Exploring short and long sounds with our voices and simple percussion instruments.

PE/Games-Practising our throwing, kicking, rolling, bouncing and stopping skills using balls.
