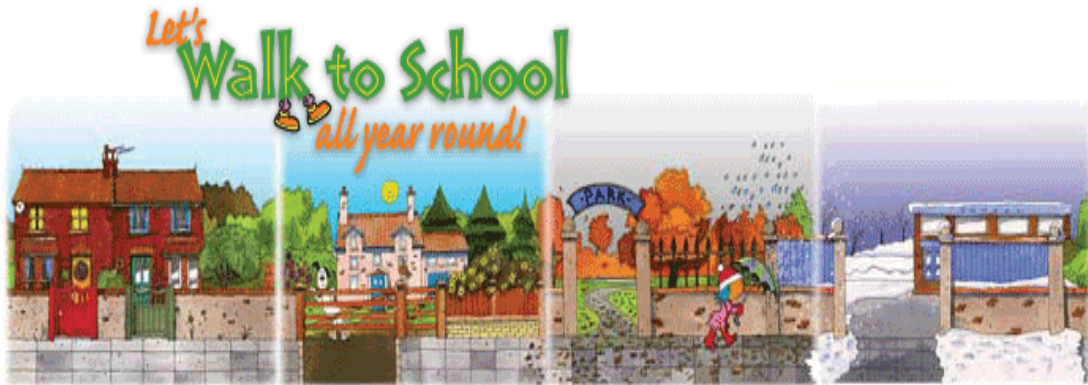


We're a Walking School!

At Watling Lower School we encourage all children to walk to school. We run a walk to school scheme and children are given rewards for having walked a certain number of days. For those travelling in from out of catchment, parents are encouraged to park and walk from behind the Langdale shops.



Children who walk arrive more alert and ready to work and build up stamina and fitness. They also learn vital road safety skills which prepare them for the time when they walk to school alone. Walking also helps to reduce traffic outside school and makes this a much safer community. If you would like your child to join the walk to school scheme, please contact the office.

Anyone driving needs to bear in mind that, with many children walking to school, pedestrian safety must take priority and dropping off or parking on the zig-zags, the corners of roads, or at the school gate is unacceptable as it puts our children at serious risk.
